## Safety Features

- The pistol has a firing pin block mechanism, which prevents involuntary firing. The block is released only when the trigger is fully pulled.
- Chamber Indicator (optional): when the chamber is loaded with a round the indicator protrudes out
  of the slide.
  - When the chamber is unloaded the indicator is aligned with the slide.
  - The indicator can be both visually and physically identified either by sight or feel.
- In the JERICHO F models, the safety lever is located on the frame. Safety mechanism blocks the sear, which blocks the movement of the trigger.
- Safety hook on the hammer: prevents the hammer hitting the firing pin when the cocked weapon is accidentally dropped.
- In the JERICHO R models, the ambidextrous safety lever is located on the slide. The safety lever
  also serves as a de-cocking mechanism. Rotating it to the SAFE position pushes the firing pin into
  the slide and releases the hammer, in a manner that does not allow firing.
   In the JERICHO R models, in the SAFE position, the trigger is neutralized.
